

Body:

The body is constructed from 12mm GRP sheet assembled with rivets to aluminium profile, all the fittings locks hinges etc are stainless steel and they are attached with stainless steel nuts bolts and lock nuts. The body is attached to the trailer chassis with 10mm stainless bolt.

The trailer has 6 doors, a hatch style kitchen, a door at the back for storage and four other doors to access fridges and storage compartments. All doors have the same key.

The trailer has a full complement of lighting including reversing and fog lights and is also fitted with an automatic brake override for reversing. The trailer has 13 pin electrics and is towed by a standard Nato hitch. The trailer is fitted with hub adaptors to enable it to take Discovery 3 wheels.

Kitchen:

The kitchen is fitted with a Smev rotisserie gas oven a two ring gas hob a microwave oven and a nespresso machine. There is a magnetic knife rack, a spice rack, a sink and hot and cold running water. There is solid teak work surface that lifts up for pot and pan storage. The control panel for the electrics is located on the left hand wall and also has usb charging sockets and dimmers for the outside lights. The drop down hatch is covered on the inside with food safe nylon so it doubles as a food prep area and chopping block.

There are two 45ltr ARB fridges, I used one for food and the other for beer! These run from 12v or mains and the switchover is automatic.

Water System:

The water system consists of a 70 liter tank that is fitted between the chassis rails of the trailer, there is access hatches for the wiring pipes and for cleaning located inside the trailer storage compartment. The tank is fitted with a level sensor that displays in percentage on the control panel, the water system is pressurised and is pumped by an automatic pump into an accumulator so there is always a constant water pressure.

Hot water is provided by an instant heat gas water heater, it starts automatically when hot water is demanded from either the shower outlet or the sink tap.

There is a float and switch system that automatically fills the coffee machine as its water gets used. Water to the tap is filtered so it is safe for drinking. There is an external hot and cold shower point.

Power System:

All onboard equipment is 12volt and is powered by two 120ah leisure batteries, these batteries can be charged using a 220v hook-up connected to the socket on the outside of the trailer or by the onboard 2.2Kw built in generator or by the 120watt solar panel fitted to the roof. Battery charging and 220v changeover from hook up to generator is fully automated.

On a slightly overcast day there is enough charge from the solar panel to keep the batteries at 100% regardless of use. The generator only really needs to be used to run the coffee machine or microwave.

The generator is built in, it doesn't need to be moved or plugged in and is electric start from the control panel in the kitchen, just turn the key.

Lighting:

There is LED lighting in every compartment (6 doors) there is a switch on every doors so only the door you open will light up and the lights will only come on when it is dark (there is a manual override)

There is plenty of lighting in the kitchen area so it is fitted with a dimmer.

There are brackets on the front of the trailer that hold two six foot high aluminium tubes with LED flood lights on them, they will light up the entire camping area and have a dimmer fitted, they can also be switched on from the tent for security.

Gas System:

The gas tank is located under the back of the trailer and is filled via the external fill point, there is a digital contents gauge for this tank, you can use bottled gas as well if you want, and the connections for this are located inside the rear storage compartment.

There is a four way valve that can isolate the gas appliances, Oven, Hob, Water Heater, and Air Heater.

The hot air propex heater is located in the rear right storage compartment with the generator, it draws in fresh air and heats it so it can be piped into the tent, the control and thermostat for this is located in the tent and has a digital temperature display and controls.

There is a gas outlet on the kitchen side of the trailer for plugging in a gas bar b q.

Tent / Awning:

The trailer is fitted with a roof tent that will sleep 3 adults comfortably, there is also a 2mtrx2mt room at the back of the trailer that will sleep two more if required or can just be used for shelter, a ladder in this room allows access to the roof tent.

Both the tent and the downstairs room are fitted with good LED lighting that can be switched independently.

The awning is 2mt x2mts and is attached to the kitchen side of the trailer so it is possible to cook in the rain without getting wet, There are two sides for the awning as well.

Location:

The trailer is presently located Nr Cork in Southern Ireland, I am happy to take whatever pictures you would like.

Viewing can be arranged, i can collect you from Cork airport and flights from the UK are really cheap.

I can also transport the trailer for you to the UK at cost.
