Interpreting Air Suspension Messages

CONDITION SUMMARY:

CUSTOMER MIS-INTERPRETATION OF AIR SUSPENSION MESSAGES

While operating the air suspension system, a customer may notice one of the following warning messages on the instrument pack message center. Both messages indicate normal operation. The messages are not related to a fault.

Parts

Refer to page 100 of the Owner's Handbook and to the following explanations.

MESSAGE	CORRECT INTERPRETATION OF EAS ACTIVITY
SUSPENSION VEHICLE RAISING SLOWLY	The message indicates that the air suspension reservoir is empty or low. The compressor is running to raise the vehicle slowly until the reservoir is fully recharged.
SUSPENSION WILL RAISE WHEN SYSTEM COOLED	The air suspension compressor has been running for an extended period (possibly through repeated operation of the raise/lower switch). To protect the compressor, the system will allow it to cool for a brief period until the temperature has dropped and normal operation can resume.
